GERERAL BUSINESS

Charter and By Laws alterations from AGM have been updated on web site.

Letter of welcome and information has been implemented and being sent to all new members. Already good feedback from recipients.

CHARITY – With full information on current Charity it has been decided to stay with this charity – Adam Jackson to deal with the charity. Unanimous

BIRDIE handicap system – still quite a few issues to sort out before any further decisions can be made. Adam Jackson dealing with Birdie officials to ensure we can utilise the system the way we need. Further discussions next meeting.

Away course slope rating for men playing forward tees as recommended at AGM by Jack Kuzina to be implemented on our system. Russell Banks to alter.

MEMBERS CHANGING TEES – Members choosing to move to forward tees no longer need to submit 3 cards as CSMG handicaps are already available and slope ratings for forward tees have now been altered.

Please note: Members can nominate to play from different tees at different courses but are advised that this can upset their handicap from white tees. Unanimous.

9 HOLE COMPETITION – The committee supports a nine hole competition run in conjunction with our scheduled 18 hole competitions. Any member can follow main field and play only 9 holes.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR – After discussing options as discussed at the AGM it has been decided to stay with the current system. It will be discussed at the end of the season if indeed this award continues next year and if so in what form.
