Upcoming AGM

- The AGM will be held at the Gymkhana Club, 13th January commencing 11am.
- All members to be emailed with the date, time and venue, and requesting that any motions that are to be put forward need to be submitted and received at least 15 days prior to the meeting.

Handicaps

- For people requiring a handicap on joining the Society, the 3 card rule still applies. However, each of the club captains will need to assess at least one of the score cards with the other cards being marked by competent golfers to ensure an accurate reflection of the golfer's ability.
- It was agreed that the Handicap Secretary can manually adjust a player's handicap at any time where justified.
- If members play at other courses and not as part of CMSG events then they are asked to submit their cards to the handicap secretary to maintain the accuracy of our handicaps. This request excludes "nomad" competitions or rounds played at Artitaya or Sand Creek.

Matches involving other golf societies

When an away tournament/game takes place in a region where a relationship exists with the local golf society it was agreed that the local golf society could join the CMSG event be that either actively involved in the tournament/competition or playing alongside the CMSG players. The level of involvement would depend on the tournament/competition and the organizer of the event.
