Ratification of AGM motions

1. Randy and Roger to be given a full vote on the Committee
2. Captains to update local rules for their respective courses. Relief from dog paw prints in bunkers to apply at all CMSG events. Human footprints no relief given.
3. Tree roots rule to remain as is. Relief only given if swing is impeded and on the fairways. No relief if stance is impeded.
4. Team events such as 2BBB are still to be used for handicap purposes. If a “pick-up” occurs then players should mark the most likely score for that hole.
5. The Committee will make best efforts for more away games, but events between courses to be left at the discretion of course captains.
6. An appointment of a rules official is deemed unnecessary
7. A discussion took place regarding introducing Khuntan as a regular venue, possibly once a month to begin with, but no decision has yet been made.
