

# **CHIANG MAI SOCIAL GOLFERS COMMITTEE MEETING**

## **HELD AT GYMKHANA GOLF CLUB 29<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2026**

The meeting commenced at 11am, there were 5 committee members present; Chris Ryan, Randy Teisl, Roger Bishop, Brian Rundle and John Orlebeck, the meeting was chaired by the President Chris Ryan. Apologies were received from Julian Wing.

1. Chris Ryan opened the meeting with a discussion regarding upcoming and proposed events to populate the 'Special Events' calendar month by month.
  - a. It was agreed that no events have been planned for January, February or March due to high season costs.
  - b. Brian said that he would contact Iain Jenson (Highlands) to discuss and arrange a possible match in April.
  - c. It was agreed that the International would be in May as in previous years. It was noted that John Orlebeck would contact Green Valley and Brian Rundle would investigate Artitaya with both to report back to the committee, regarding timings and costs.

  - d. In June (date to be confirmed) will be the Ric Cameron Trophy held at Maejo.
  - e. Roger to discuss with Sanuk Sabai (Sherman Miles) to set up a possible match to reinstate the Ryder Cup, date and venue to be agreed.
  - f. Currently August and September are free, however Chris Ryan said he would discuss with the team at Chiang Mai/Chiang Rai Cup for possible dates.
  - g. October is the Annual Tournament, dates and venues to be decided.
  - h. In November sometime the Chiang Rai Cup, also the Annual Dinner.
  - i. December free.
2. Brian said that he was willing to maintain the 'Hole in One' register on our website. He also agreed to handle the trophies presented at the Annual Dinner. He said that the photos of recipients of the HIO cannot be stored on the website for longer than 2 months. Randy agreed that he would add them to the CMSG Facebook page as and when they happen.
3. Chris Ryan followed up his comment from the recent AGM regarding communication, after some debate we agree to maintain existing LINE accounts (Maejo/Haripunchai/CMSG) and to monitor all activities.
4. It was agreed that an email should be sent to all members reminding them that when returning from an extended absence from CMSG they must supply their last 20 differentials to the Handicap Secretary thus adjusting their CMSG Handicap.
5. It was agreed that a committee meeting would be held at Gymkhanna on the 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday of every month at 11am. It was further agreed that an email would be sent to all members the week prior, asking if anyone had issues that they would like to have discussed.
